DISTRIBUTION OF RECEIVED DONATIONS

All donations collected through different channels (private initiatives, City, etc.) have been grouped together in order to facilitate their distribution to the victims.

CLOTHES (IN GENERAL)

Pont aux Lions, 1 (former C&A)

Clothes / bed linen / blankets / childcare equipment / children's toys / sleeping bags / etc.

- from Monday, 9 August 2021
- Monday to Friday, from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. (closed on weekends)
- access limited to people in possession of a <u>damage certificate</u> (issued at the "Fonds des calamités" counter, Place du Marché, 9, open 8:30 a.m. 12 p.m. / 2 p.m. to 4 p.m.)

Victims of flooding will receive assistance depending on their needs (no free choice).

FURNITURE AND HOUSEHOLD APPLIANCES

Tables, chairs, beds, wardrobes, crockery, infant chairs, strollers, sundries, washing machines, microwave ovens, etc.

The purpose is for the victims to receive <u>personalised</u> assistance (i.e. adapted to the personal situation).

This assessment will depend on the field actors (social workers of the partner services associated with the coordination).

The received donations will be distributed depending on the needs identified by the social workers. A delivery service is being set up.

FOOD AID AND ESSENTIAL PRODUCTS

Since the beginning of the crisis, several local centres have distributed food and essential products. This help was supplemented during the first few weeks by many private initiatives.

Now, the usual food aid actors are able to meet <u>all</u> the food aid needs, opening up, if necessary, to other actors than the usual ones.

Besides, the significant field work that was carried out enabled to identify the needs of the victims and to provide personalised answers, that respect their dignity.

Therefore:

- The **local centres set up by the City** are already closed or will be by 9 August 2021 at the latest.



- The **home delivery of hot meals** provided by the coordinated work of different non-profit organisations and many volunteers will end on 13 August 2021.
- A shuttle bus will be set up thanks to TEC Liège/Verviers from (in order to help the victims with no means of transport to be able to go grocery shopping again:

Outward journey	Return journey
Hôtel Verviers - rue de la Station Rue Peltzer de Clermont (temporary stop) Rue de la Concorde Place de la Victoire Rue du Palais Place Sommeleville Rue de Limbourg Roundabout at the bottom of Stember	Same journey for the return trip, <u>except</u> that Place de la Victoire, the bus will go down rue d'Ensival to take Boulevard de Gérardchamps and go back to Hôtel Verviers.

The different actors will collaborate, providing each other all necessary support to manage the extra work due to this crisis.

About the **private initiatives** of food distribution or actions for the victims, do not forget that:

- All rules relative to the food chain safety must be strictly respected;
- You should insure coordination with the field actors beforehand (by calling the "volunteer coordination" service of the city of Verviers): 087/326.050)

OTHER

RECEPTION AREA

A **reception area** will be maintained at the library (C.P.I. – Place du Marché, 9 in 4800 Verviers) at least until 23 August 2021. Any victim of the flooding will find a place to express their needs. They will be listened to and guided.

During the implementation period of the new system (thus temporarily), a **distribution point** will remain at l'Ecole du Centre, Rue Ortmans Hauzeur, 26 in 4800 Verviers).

FACILITIES

Mobile showers have been installed on place du Marché and Grand Place in Ensival.

Access from 5 p.m. to 9 p.m. (towels and hygiene products are available).

From 9 August, from 6 pm to 8:30 pm.

Mobile toilets are available:

HOUSING

EMERGENCY ACCOMMODATION

DUS (Dispositif d'Urgence Sociale - Social Emergency Plan) contact only by phone at 087 352 121 for an individualised solution.

STABILITY

Access to the buildings identified as problematic by the teams of the town hall is prohibited by decree. Only an architect or a stability engineer can lift this decree. They are the only ones allowed in the premises. Their positive report must then be forwarded to the Travaux (Works) department (087 327 502 – <u>travaux-ba@verviers.be</u>).

If you notice an urgent problem, contact the emergency services (112).

ENERGY AND WATER

The relevant companies are working to restore electricity and gas. Most problematic situations have be solved. For more information about these questions, please contact:

ADVICE

In any damaged building, it is always recommended to:

- Ventilate as much as possible;
- Clean with bleach (respecting all precautions for use)

CHILD CARE

Child care at l'Ecole du Centre: rue Ortmans Hauzeur 26. Open from Monday, 2 August until Friday 27 August, from 10 am to 5 pm.

"FONDS DES CALAMITÉS" DESK/ INSURANCES

There are permanent offices at the municipal administration: in front of the city hall, place du Marché, 9 from 8:30 a.m. to 12 pm and from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. from Monday to Friday (087 326 000). That desk can issue damage certificates.

You can also receive assistance to fill in the online damage declaration form following the same schedule.

CARE AND PSYCHOLOGICAL SUPPORT
